

## Student Ambassador Guidelines

Each school year students grades 9-12 are invited to enroll in the United Way of the Bradford Area Inc. Student Ambassador program.

\*There is no maximum on number of student who can enroll

## Requirements:

- Each ambassador will be required to complete an Ambassador Application
- Each ambassador will be required to sign a photo release
- Each ambassador will be assigned to a funded agency to meet with and learn about the United Way's impact upon the agency
- Each ambassador will be encouraged to speak at various engagements on behalf of the United Way and/or the agency they were assigned to
- Each ambassador will be invited to attend a Campaign Presentation and are encouraged to attend; this will count towards hours and volunteer engagements

The following list is a description of the role of a United Way Ambassadors:

- An ambassador is to be a Bradford Area High School student in good standing
- An ambassador is to be respectful and have the ability to speak openly and positively about the UWBA and their community
- A senior ambassador is eligible for a scholarship to be awarded at the annual awards assembly
- Ambassadors will be recognized at the United Way annual Red Feather ceremony

The following is a list of expectations of each Student Ambassador:

- An ambassador is encouraged to attend all United Way special events —when appropriate
- An ambassador is provided a United Way t-shirt and it is to be worn at all UWBA events
- An ambassador is encouraged to complete 10 hours of community service under the UWBA
- Student ambassadors should submit a summary of any United Way volunteer experience within seven (7) days of community involvement; the summary should indicate a review of the 'event' and what the student learned from their involvement.
  - o Summaries are to be one-page or less, double spaced, Times New Roman font
